NOW THESE PRESENTS WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS :

The Effounders above-named hereby establish a public Charitable Trust by the hame of K.M.C. EDUCATIONAL TRUST with the objects and dron the terms and conditions hereinafter mentioned.

012. Initial Trust Funds :

e Founders have this day contributed, as authors of the Trust, in all a of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousands Only) towards the Trust Funds as



3. TRUST PROPERTY

The Trust property shall comprise of the said initial trust fund as well as all other amounts, securities, properties movables and immovables which may be contributed or donated by the Founders, Trustees, members of the public or any one else or from any other source and shall also include all



drivions, accretions, and acquisitions made by the Trust and the income hexeived by the Trust from time to time. Trust property shall vest in the further than the provisions hereof for the due the filliment of the objects of the Trust.

4. OFFICE OF THE TRUST:

CANDH

The principal office of the Trust shall at 658-664, Dr. Rajendraprasad Road, Ganapathy Village, COIMBATORE - 641 012 and at the discretion of the majority of the Trustees can be shifted to any other place in India, by passing a special Resolution for the shifting at the General meeting of the Trust.

5. NATURE OF THE TRUST:

This Trust shall be a Public Charitable Trust having no commercial or profit motives. It shall be maintained and administered to provide basic school level educational initially to all in the country and to promote education in general and popularise extension of education in the field of Engineering technology, Management Science and Pure Sciences, and conduct courses to cultivate talents in sciences, particularly in Engineering technology, in the

younger generation of the society and general education, and any other objects of general public utility. The benefits of this Trust shall ensure to all sections of publicular hole without any distinction as to the caste or creed or race or colour. The Trust's funds and income shall be applied solely towards promotion of the object for which this Trust is established.

6. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST :

- I) To promote fundamental education by starting a Primary and Secondary School in the first place and popularise extension of Education in the field of engineering technology, Paramedical and Bio-Technology, Management Science, Pure Sciences, Arts and Indian Culture.
- II) To disseminate knowledge and cultivate talents in Para medical and Biotechnology, Engineering and related technology, particularly among the younger generation of the society, by organizing seminars, lectures, bringing out publications, promoting quality text book writing among the teachers, retired school teachers and college professors, organising a library for research oriented books and publishing as monographs, mimeographs, on in other printed or computerized forms of all the educational material for the benefit of the younger generation with the aim of developing a qualified younger generation in the Engineering, Paramedical, Biotechnology and related field.
- III) To establish institutions for conducting courses for the students from school level onwards, in the field of Paramedical and Bio-technology, Engineering and related technology. These programmers may be linked with projects from various institutions/universities and management, finance education and establishment of permanent structures like seminar halls, conference rooms, hostel and other centers.
- Iv)To start research centers and to find out the immense possibilities of yogic enlightenment by which the developments of the individual and the society can be realized in order to establish a peaceful and harmonious human society.
- v) To engage qualified specialists, teachers, instructors and other staff to run research camps and other institutions, camps and centers.
- vi) To establish, takeover, maintain, run, subsidize, help and make donations to hostels, boarding and lodging houses for students and staff in connection with such institutions.
- vii) To institute and award scholarships and grant loans for study and research to poor and needy persons deserving help and encouragement.
- vill) To start various types of short term and long term courses in furtherance of the main objectives of the trust with the affiliation from the

respective university and with the approval of the respective government institutions.

Ix) To promote civic consciousness and develop discipline and obedience to the Rule of Law in the public.

- x) To sponsor and/or support and/or contribute in cash or in kind and/or conduct youth development projects or research camps as may be decided upon from time to time by the Trustees.
- xi) To accept donations, grants, presents and gifts, either in cash or in kind, for the purpose of the Trust and to adopt all lawful courses, means and measures for raising funds for the Trust.
- xil) To do all such other lawful things as are incidental or conductive to the attainment of the above objects.
- xiii) To undertake all other types of objects of a charitable nature which help the attainment of relief to the poor, education, medical relief and/or the advancement of general public utility not being specifically mentioned in the clauses above.
- xlv) It is made clear that this Trust will not carry any activity with the intention of earning profit.
- xv) The benefits of the Trust shall be open to all members of the public irrespective of caste, creed, clout, religion, sex etc.,

7. MANAGEMENT OF TRUST:

- a. This Trust shall be administered by a Board of Trustees whose Number shall not be less than two or more than eleven. The founders shall be the permanent Trustees of the board. The remaining members other than Founder Trustees shall be elected by the general body of the trust and the duration of these trustees will be One year from the date of election till the next Annual General Meeting. In the case of any vacancies arises due to resignation, death etc., any other member will be co-opted by the board of the trustees for the remaining period. Shri. C.S. MANOHARAN, Founder Trustee shall be the Managing Trustee of the Trust during his life time.
 - b The Trustees shall elect the Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary from among themselves once in 2 years. The routine administration of the Trust, its property and affairs, convening meetings of the Trustees, maintaining minutes, accounts, records and other documents, of the trust shall be looked after by the Chairman/Secretary of the Board of Trustees.
 - c. The Chairman of the Board of Trustees shall have, subject to the control, direction and superintendence of the Board of Trustees, all and every power

for the purpose of managing, conducting and administering the affairs of the Trust and institutions and establishments owned, run or conducted by the Trust. The board of Trustees shall appoint a Directors / Correspondents and principals /Head Masters for the unday to day administration for the Institutions founded by the trust.

- d. To open account(s) in the name of the Trust, and institutions—run or conducted by the Trust with a bank or banks, to operate such account(s) and to give instructions to the bank(s) and to provide for opening and operation of such account(s) by any two of the following office bearers being the Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.
- e. The Chairman shall arrange for the maintenance of correct and proper accounts of the receipts and payments of the Trust and the assets and liabilities of the Trust.
- f. The accounts of the Trust shall be closed as on the 31st. March of every year, and an income and expenditure account for the year ended and Balance Sheet as at that date shall be prepared and such accounts shall be audited by the Auditor who shall be a Chartered Accountant. The first auditor shall be appointed by the Board of Trustees on such remuneration as they may decide.
- g. The permanent trustees shall cease to hold office of the trust in the event of
 - i) Death, Insolvency
 - II) If he voluntarily resigns from the office of the trust,
- iii) At the option of the Board of Trustees if he continuously absents himself for four consecutive meetings without leave of absence.
- iv) If general body of the members decides with three fourth majority of the members present at that meeting.
- h. Within six months after the close of the accounting year, the Board of Trustees shall place the said audited Balance Sheet as at and the Income and Expenditure Account for the year ending 31st March Immediately preceding before the General Body of the Trust for which at least 7 days notice shall be sent to every member together with a copy of the Balance Sheet, Income and Expenditure Account and Report of the Board of Trustees on the activities of the Trust during the preceding year.
- I. At this general meeting an auditor who shall be a Chartered Accountant shall be appointed for the Trust to hold office till the conclusion of the next Annual General Body.

(I). Any person having phyantiropic aptitude and is so recognized and recommended by any of the Trustees is eligible to become a member of "K.M.C. EDUCATIONAL TRUST but to the approval of the board of Trustees.

- j. The members of K.M.C. EDUCATIONAL TRUST Colmbatore, shall constitute the General Body of the Trust.
- k. The members of the K.M.C. EDUCATIONAL TRUST shall only be eligible to be appointed as trustee.
- (i). Any member acting against the Interest of the trust and against the main principles for which the trust is established, shall be relieved from the membership of the trust without any further action or notice or deed any only by passing a resolution in the Board meeting of the Board of trustees.
- I. The Board of Trustees may adopt a budget for the ensuing year at such appropriate time as they deem it.
- m. The funds of the Trust shall be invested as may be decided by the Board of Trustees from time to time, either in securities by the Indian Trust Act and/or in scheduled banks as authorized under the Income Tax Act and/or purchase or contribution of land and buildings, in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as may be in force from time to time.
- n. All investments belonging to the Trust shall be vested in the Trustees for the time being. On any trustee ceasing to be a trustee, the Trust investments shall cease to vest in her/him and on the induction of any new trustee, the trust investments shall vest in the new trustee also along with the other continuing trustees.
- o. Upon every appointment of trustees and upon every retirement of a trustee such deeds and other acts as the trustees may prescribe for the purpose of vesting all investments in the trust shall be executed jointly by the retiring and continuing trustees if found necessary.

8. POWERS OF TRUSTEES:

- a) The Board of Trustees shall have power to vary investments already made either by sale, exchange or otherwise.
- b) The Board of Trustees shall have power to make and prescribe additional rules and regulations for the purpose of carrying out any of the objects of the Trust.
- c) In the event of the dissolution of the Trust, the properties of the Trust shall be handed over to one or more public Charitable Trusts

having objects of 'Charitable Ringse as refined in the Income Tax Act, 1961 as may be unanimously decided by the Vrustees.

- d) To receive, collect and enforcement of all monles due or payable to the Trust and grant nercestary receipts and discharge there for.
- e) To appoint, terminate, suspend and otherwise deal with the employees.
 - f) To appeal and set before courts, tribunals, public offices, etc.
- g) To Institute, prosecute and defend all sults and other legal proceedings.
- h) To incur all necessary expenses from the corpus of income of the Trust in connection with the Trust and its management and for its institutions.
- I) To apply properties and funds of the Trusts for the objects of the Trust.
- j) Generally to do all such acts, deeds and funds as may be required to fulfill the purposes of the Trust and matters incidental thereto.
- k) It shall be lawful for the trustees to settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or dispute, claim, demand or things, proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- I) It shall be lawful for the trustees to borrow money either on the security of any property belonging to the trust or otherwise to fulfill and or all of the aims and, objects of the Trust, and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make this borrowing and the payment of any interest that may result on such terms and conditions as they think fit.
- m) Within six months after the close of the accounting year, the Board of Trustees shall place the said audited Balance Sheet as at and the Income and Expenditure account for the year ending 31st March immediately preceding before the General Body of the Trust for which at least 7 days notice shall be sent to every member together with a copy of the Balance Sheet, Income and Expenditure Account and Report of the Board of Trustees on the activities of the Trust during the preceding year.

9. AMALGAMATION:

It shall be lawful for the Trust to take over or amalgamate with any other charitable trust, society, association or institution with similar alms and objects. It shall also be lawful for the Trust to establish, promote,

manage, organize or maintain, on to assist in establishing, promoting, managing, organizing or maintaining ally branen of the frust to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation or only other charitable trust, society, association or institution with blooms.

10. TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS BY THE TRUSTEES:

- a) The Trustees shall meet once in 3 months or as often as may be necessary for the efficient conduct of the affairs of the Trust. Such meeting shall be presided over by the Chairman of the Trust or in his absence or inability, by one of the Trustees elected by the Trustees to be the Chairman of the meeting.
- b) Two Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees;
- c) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustees or by the majority of the trustees at a meeting convened for that purpose.
- d) Resolutions may be passed without holding a meeting of the Trustees by circulating in writing the proposed resolutions which must be endorsed in this manner they shall be as valid and effectual as resolutions passed at a meeting of the Trustees.
- e) The Chairman of the meeting shall be entitled to a casting vote in the event of equality of votes at the meeting.
- f) A meeting of the trustees may be called by the Secretary of any three of the trustees on not less than seven days notice in writing specifying the date, place and hour of such meeting and the nature of the business to be transacted at the meeting and such notice shall be sent by post or delivered to every trustees. The accidental omission to give notice to or the non-receipt of notice by any trustee shall not invalidate the proceedings at any such meeting. With the consent of all the trustees a meeting may be convened by such shorter notice as in such manner as the trustees may think fit.
- g) On all important matters and in particular in the matter of investing or exercising the borrowing powers, the decision of the board of trustees at a meeting or by circular resolution shall be necessary.
- h) A minute book shall be maintained in which shall be recorded the proceedings of every meetings of the trustees and shall be signed by the Chairman of that meeting.
- i) The continuing trustee or trustees may act notwithstanding any vacancy in their body.

- j) All acts done by the thustegs of any of them of by any person acting and afterwards discovered that there was defect in the appointment of any trustees or that any trustee was disqualified it was valid as if every such person had been duly appointed and was published to be a trustee.
- k) Any trustee may at any time with the consent of all his co trustees delegate all or any of his duties or powers to any other person or persons, whether a co-trustee or trustee or not.
- The trustees may appoint any trustee or other person to attend to or carry out special function connected with the management of affairs of the trust.
- m) The trustees shall be entitled to reimbursement of all expenses incurred by them for the purpose of the trust.
- n) The trustees for the time being shall have the dustody of all deeds and documents of title relating to trust property and investments and the books of account and other records relating to the trust and shall be responsible for the same.

11. THE ACCOUNTS AND MINUTES:

The Trustees shall maintain true and correct accounts of all receipts and payments and dealings in regard to the Trust property and shall also maintain the correct record of their meetings and deliberations.

- 12. The activities of the trust would be confined to the Territories of India. Any amendment to the Trust deed would be carried out only with the approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax, Colmbatore.
- 13. Any alienation of immovable property shall be done with the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax, Colmbatore

14. INDEMNITY:

The Trustees shall be fully kept indemnified and harmless by the Trust against any action or claim, loss suffered or liability arising against them, on account of anything done by them in good faith pursuant to the powers and authority conferred on them by these presents.

15. IRREVOCABILITY/ AMENDMENTS OF THE TRUST:

The provisions of this Trust may be altered or amended by the resolution passed by the Board of Trustees either unanimously or with the consent of the simple majority provided the character of this Trust as a Charitable

16. PROVISIONS OF DETERMINATION OF THE TRUET

In the event of the determination of the Trust or if this Trust should fall in any reason the Trustees shall make over or transfer the funds and properties of this Trust to any other Trust or Institution having objects generally similar to those of this Trust and donations to which are exempt U/S 80-G of the Income Tax Act, 1961, if the resolution to that effect is passed by the Trustees unanimously or by not less than three-fourth majority.

17. It is further declared that

No part of the income shall be applied for the benefit of any of the persons mentioned in section 13(3) of the Income Tax Act, 1961. Income derived from the trust shall be applied for the purposes mentioned only in India. There is no mentioned to income the present.

18. ACCEPTANCE OF THE TRUST:
