Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from

14. the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.

Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.

The Manger and the Principal of the school shall be jointly 16. responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/ information/data submitted by the School to the Board.

Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and

- circulars/guidelines/notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per clause 12 of Affiliation Bye-laws-2018.
- The genuineness of information / documents / data submitted shall 18, be of school and in case, if found otherwise the school shall invite action as per affiliation Bye laws-2018

The extension of affiliation is being granted as one time measure.

21. However, the cases where the Show Cause Notice was communicated or grievance / legal cases are pending against the school, the Board will take appropriate decision in this matter.

22. Drinking Water & Health and Hygiene certificate, Fire Safety Certificate and Building Safety Certificate from concerned Govt authorities time to time
